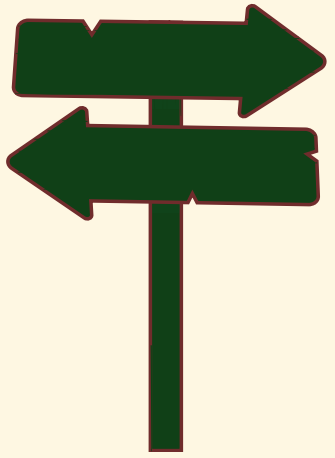


LIFE IN THE FOREST THE MONSOON EDIT

A few friendly tips for enjoying life in the forest



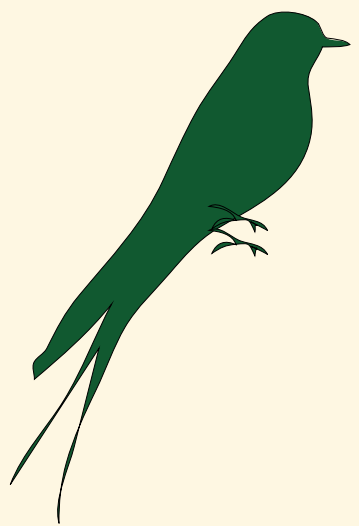
Use Designated pathways
